About the Certified Playground Safety Inspector (CPSI) Program

According to the Consumer Product Safety Commission, 200,000 children are treated annually for playground equipment-related injuries. Of these, 74-percent, or 148,000 involve public playground equipment. Many of these accidents could have been prevented. National Recreation and Park Association's (NRPA) major initiative in raising playground safety awareness is the administration of the Certified Playground Safety Inspector (CPSI) training and certification program. The CPSI course is designed to properly train individuals to recognize and prevent potential playground hazards.

The CPSI course is the most comprehensive training program on playground hazard identification and risk management methods that is offered today. Advanced reading and 15 hours of training will prepare you to take the CPSI exam scheduled at the culmination of the certification course.

Professional Certification

Course participants are eligible to take the optional Certified Playground Safety Inspector exam given immediately after the course. Passing the test means certification by National Recreation and Park Association as a Certified Playground Safety Inspector (CPSI). Certificates will be awarded and your name will be added to the national register of CPSIs. An exam will be required for renewal after three years. **CEU Credit: Participants may obtain 1.5 credits for participating in the course.**

Pre-Registration

Pre-register by completing and returning the following form, and fees, to MRPA by **Wednesday, March 30**. A confirmation email will be sent and study materials will be mailed upon receipt of registration and payment.

Class Schedule and Size

The course runs from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on the first two days. The optional certification exam runs from 8 to 11:30 a.m. on the third day. Minimum registration is 25 participants to hold a class; maximum is 60 participants. Please register early.

Accommodations Request

A candidate who has a disability may request a special accommodation; the request must be submitted in writing at the time of course or exam registration. In order to properly accommodate all persons with disabilities it is recommended that all requests be made 45 days prior to the scheduled date for the course and exam. English as a second language (ESL) candidates may request a time extension and/or the use of a strict translation dictionary. Request forms/fees must be submitted to NRPA no less than 30 days prior to the exam. The request form is available online at www.nrpa.org/cpsi. The course host will work cooperatively with NRPA to ensure all approved reasonable accommodations are met.

Health and Safety
